

# ***First Dance Emergency Kit***

*This addresses common, easily fixable mishaps and provides ease of mind on your wedding day.*

- ***Heel Protectors:*** Clear caps for anyone walking on grass, ensuring they don't sink, and adding stability and protection for the dance floor.
- ***Spare Flat Shoes:*** A comfortable pair of shoes for both of you. Pain free is essential for a graceful dance.
- ***A Small Towel / Handkerchief:*** For quick brow dabs before the dance begins—nerves and bright lights can cause nervous sweat.
- ***Safety Pins:*** The most common last minute issue is a broken bustle or a torn hem. Keep several robust pins handy to tack the dress back up instantly.
- ***Lint Roller:*** For dark suits, a quick once-over ensures no stray hairs or lint are caught by high resolution cameras.
- ***Mouthwash/Mints:*** For that perfect end-of-dance kiss and those close-up photos.

***Pro-Tip:*** Designate your Day-of-Wedding Coordinator, Maid of Honor, or other trusted person to keep this kit at the head table or DJ booth—the two most accessible locations that remain off camera during your first dance. Having it within arms reach ensures a last minute fix without retreating to a dressing room. If using the DJ booth, ask permission first.
